This is the sixth workshop in the series of GEMS workshops in Slovakia; the previous five were in Donovaly (1994), Banská Bystrica (1997), Bratislava (2001), Stará Lesná (2005), and Tále (2009). This year's GEMS workshop will take place in the Congress Centre at the Smolenice Castle, located about one-hour drive or bus ride from Bratislava. The workshop will also be a part of a series of events marking the 50th anniversary of the first important international conference on graph theory which took place at the Smolenice Castle in 1963.

The programme will consist of one-hour invited lectures and 20-minutes contributed talks.

The contributed talks are expected to address topics related to the title of the workshop, such as embeddings of graphs on surfaces, symmetric embeddings and regular maps, group actions on graphs and maps, combinatorial properties of embedded graphs, representativity, graph minors, convex polytopes and polytopal graphs, dessins d'enfants, and enumeration of maps.
